THE INSTITUTION

Bethesda Women Teachers' Training College, Ranchi was established in 1987 by G.E.L. Church, Ranchi a Registered Society as Minority Institution under Article 29 and 30 of the constitution of India. Since its inception, it is making sustainable efforts to impart value-based education to young female graduates of Jharkhand and other state which is a multi lingual and multi dimensional state which offers congenial educational atmosphere for Teacher Education.

The College is situated in the middle of City on a piece of land measuring 3.02 Acres having boundary on all sides. It has its own building. The campus is adorned by orchards and flower plants which makes teaching learning situation meaningful as well as attractive. It has an excellent computer centre and well stocked library.

The College has permanent recognition from Eastern Regional Committee Bhubaneshwar of National Council for Teacher Education. It is also Permanently affiliated to Ranchi University, Ranchi. The college is accredited form NAAC Bangluru with B+ Cycle one The course of M.Ed is of two years duration, starting from 1st July and ends & 31st of May.

The College maintains a high standard of teaching learning situation, which is reflected by its University results. It organizes co-curricular activities in the campus during the session. The teaching staff are well qualified all having post graduate degrees in school subjects as well as in Education with good educational achievements. Some of them possess NET and Ph.D. Degree too.

OBJECTIVE OF THE COLLEGE

The College prepares Teachers of character dedicated to their profession and to teach in secondary school, orients them to cherish national and cultural values of secularism, communal harmony, democratic ideals, makes them enable with such ideas so as to be agents of women emancipation. The College offers two year M.Ed. Course and is open to the students irrespective of caste / religion and creeds. As such freedom of religious beliefs of students will be respected.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

1. As per NCTE norms, a candidate should have secured at least 50% marks in the aggregate for S.C / S.T and 55% for

General at the B.Ed and Master's Degree examination of a recognized University.

2. Only 50 students will be admitted.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. A Candidate applying for admission must enclose self attested photocopies of Marks-Sheet & Certificates with the application as well as Caste Certificate (SC/ST/OBC), Residential Certificate, Income Certificate (SC/ST/OBC) and Medical Certificate obtained from competent authority.
2. Late and incomplete application will not be considered.
3. Exerting any undue influence on the authorities of College will disqualify the Candidate.
4. The candidate must obtain a receipt with regard to submission of the application in college.
5. Any tampering with the Marks-Sheet and Certificate will disqualify the candidate even after admission.
6. The selection list will be prepared on the merit basis.
7. The Reservation quota of State Govt, will be provided.
8. At the time of admission of selected candidate's original marks sheet and all certificates mentioned above will be taken for scrutiny. However the originals will be returned after scrutiny except C.L.C.
9. Candidates having passed from other University will be required to deposit Original Migration Certificate for Registration from Ranchi University.
10. Selected candidate must submit at the time of admission a Medical Certificate from competent authority to the effect that **she is physically and mentally fit and not pregnant so that she** may bear the stress and strain of course transaction.
11. The selection list prepared on the basis of Merit and results will be displayed at College Notice Board. as well as website of college.
12. The applicant must be a resident of Jharkhand State as per Govt, order.
13. The candidate belonging to disabled category must submit a certificate in this regard given by competent authority.

PLEASE NOTE :-

1. A Candidate is not allowed to abandon the course in mid-session.
2. If she does so, she will not be entitled of refund of fees already paid to the College.
3. The student's name is liable to be dropped from the rolls, if she remains absent continuously for more than 10 days without Notice.
4. A trainee must attend all College functions and participate in co-curricular activities organized by the Institution.
5. All the trainees must also attend all College functions and cultural programmes, seminars, debates, picnics, community services, exposure programme, educational tours etc.
6. No trainee shall collect any money as contribution for picnic, trip, educational visits, get-togethers, study notes, charity for any other activity without the prior permission of the Principal.
7. No students should invite any person for any function or dialogue in the College without the prior permission of the Principal.
8. The trainees are expected to take proper care of the College property and help to maintain the premises neat and tidy.
